<b>Cancellation Policy</b>	You can change the date of your tour or cancel with a full refund with 48 hours' notice. If you cancel within 48 hours, you will receive no refund.
<b>Private Tour Fee</b>	To ensure exclusivity and privacy for a Capital Tastes or Walking Gourmet group of up to eight guests (i.e. no other guests booked on the tour) a supplementary fee as stated within each tour applies. We offer 1pm private tours Monday to Friday for guests who unable to join our standard 9.30am tours. This private tour fee also applies for private foreign language tours.
<b>Tailored Tours</b>	There is a design fee for creating tailored tours of \$100 per tour, payable whether tour proceeds or not.
<b>Pricing Terms</b>	We endeavor to hold our prices for the duration of the season specified but reserve the right to change our pricing due to changes beyond our control which impact tour costs such as tax increases.
<b>Credit card processing fee</b>	For any payments by credit card a 3.5% processing fee applies.
<b>Single Supplement fee</b>	Unfortunately, our tours are for a minimum of 2 guests. If a single traveler wishes to undertake a tour, and there are no other bookings for that day, they will be required to pay for 2 persons to ensure the tour proceeds. Naturally we will not charge the single supplementary fee if other guests subsequently book for the same tour.
